# WHAT DOES Ganley Ford DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

### Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

#### What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number and income
- account balances and payment historycredit history and credit scores

### How?

All financial companies need to share **customer's** personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their **customer's** personal information; the reasons **Ganley Ford** chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.
Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.
	<ul> <li>Our affiliates include companies with common ownership and control; financial company - Heritage Acceptance Corporation; non-financial companies such as Eastway Insurance Agency, Inc.</li> </ul>
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.
	Nonaffilates we share with include banks, other finance companies and direct marketing companies.
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.
	Our joint marketing partners include finance institutions, automobile manufacturers, financial and insurance product providers.
